



CROSS CULTURE - Mission Partners David & Cathy Walter | AFES - Australia | Pacific Islands

I'm witing to you from Fiji, as I prepare to fly to the Solomons tomorrow, in time for the official start of SPARC (the South Pacific Regional Conference) on Thursday.



The last month has been heavy with meetings and preparations for various things on various fronts. But now it's back into the islands and time for my major event for the year.

I'm feeling quite tired and Cathy (who will fly from Brisbane to the Solomons tomorrow) is feeling less than fully healthy.

Kelvin Loo & Yen Ping | Pioneers - Thailand

Prayer Points

- Praise God for our time of Home Assignment.
- Strength, wisdom, and favour as we plan for the September-October Next Step training.
- Kelvin's DMin. Kelvin's thesis is on Sabbath for the C workers. We hold a one-day silent retreat for the workers to rest and focus on God in most of our trainings. There has been much positive informal feedback on how this simple time has blessed the participants in their relationship with God. Pray that Kelvin will be able to complete all the necessary DMin work by the upcoming Next Step training, so that he can gather some formal feedback for his doctorate this time.

- The number of trainings and care that our larger team here is providing
 is increasing. It can be emotionally and spiritually draining as we bear
 the burdens of the precious ones who come to us for care and training.
 This has reached a stage where we need to consider how much we can
 commit to individually, as well as to the team, so that we can continue to
 minister healthily. Pray for us in this.
- For our family to manage the transitions between countries well. As
 adults, we can sometimes feel overwhelmed in navigating the various
 systems of each country in which we are involved. Our children feel it
 too, but may not be able to express it. Pray that we will be able to help
 our kids cope and even thrive as Third Culture Kids (TCKs).

Shao Xiong, Levene & Emma | OMF - Japan

BIBLE READING EPHESIANS 6: 10-24

10Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. **13**Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. **14**Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. **17**Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

18And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. 19Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should. 21Tychicus, the dear brother and faithful servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am and what I am doing. 22I am sending him to you for this very purpose, that you may know how we are, and that he may encourage you. 23 Peace to the brothers, and love with faith from God the Father and the Lord Iesus Christ. 24Grace to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love.
