


We are a Bible-centered church that exists to bring glory to God.





CHURCH FINANCE:

FY 2024 Budget



As the building funds will now be in a separate account, we have split our budget into Building Fund, Missions Fund and General Fund with respective bank accounts for each fund.

Over the year, we plan to provide snapshots in the Friend to show how we are tracking financially and where we may still need to meet our budget. For the moment, here is an update on the budget allocations for your donations.

General Fund: \$137,500. This fund pays the salaries of our staff, supports day-to-day and administrative costs.

Building Fund: \$131,000. This fund will be used for the maintaining and improving our church facilities. It also covers the costs for the Southside Garden construction works.

Missions Fund: \$38,000. This fund supports our mission partners.

Tax-Deductible Gifts

Tax-deductible monetary contributions can now be made to our church for building-related expenses (e.g. building projects, repairs, cleaning).

Up till now, non-tax-deductible offerings from you have been kept in a general church account, and all expenses have been drawn from this account. Recently, we have established that our church is eligible to receive tax-deductible donations for expenses limited to building-related items, so we have set up a new bank account to facilitate donations for those who are interested.

The Australian Taxation Office (ATO) refers to non-profit organisations that can receive tax-deductible donations as a "Deductible Gift Recipient" (DGR), and we refer to these terms below.

Guidelines for DGR-related Giving:

2. Recommended Minimum Donation Amount:

As tax receipts will be manually issued, we kindly ask that you keep the Building Fund contributions to a minimum of \$250. This will allow our team to better manage the administrative requirements for issuing tax receipts.

3. Issuing of Tax Receipts:

For all first-time donors, please kindly email lscc54@gmail.com with your full name and amount contributed. This will allow our finance team to correctly issue the tax receipt in a timely manner.


ACCESSING BACK HALL AFTER CHURCH SERVICE:


Sunday service - 23rd Mar 2024:

BIBLE READING COLOSSIANS 2:6-23

6So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, **7**rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. **8**See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ. **9**For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, **10**and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority. **11**In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ, 12 having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. **13**When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, **14** having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. 15And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

16Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. **17**These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ. **18**Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. **19**He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. **20**Since you died with Christ to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules: **21**"Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"? **22**These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based on human commands and teachings. **23**Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their selfimposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.
